REGULAR MEETING

Roll Call: Howard Heavner, Kyle Duffy, Rob Nowlan, Tim Valentine, Kaylee Dependahl were all present with Butch Ford and Adam Tyberendt absent. Also in attendance were Dennis Knobloch, Larry Andres, Tim Richards, Larry Chausse, Terry Marquardt and Mike Garavalia. There being a quorum present the meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by President Heavner, at the Village Hall.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved with a motion by Valentine, second by Nowlan, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion carried.

The monthly expenditures were read. A motion to approve was made by Duffy, second by Dependahl, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion carried.

The Maintenance report was presented. A motion to approve was made by Valentine, second by Nowlan, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion passed.

The Police report was reviewed. A motion to approve was made by Duffy, second by Dependahl, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion passed.

- Emergency Services: Valentine said that Chausse had gathered more information on the license plate reading cameras. Chausse said that was the case, and he is also looking into grants that may be available for purchasing those systems.

Old Business:

Barmann update-Tim reported that the contractor has obtained the engineer's report and would be doing an onsite inspection on 12/3 to determine the exact scope of work so a project quote can be given to the Village for review.

Siren update- Tim said the new siren has been installed and worked when they tested it after installation. It has now been determined that the siren cannot currently be activated by the dispatchers, so the siren company will be working on that in the coming weeks to determine the problem and fix the problem so the siren can be remotely activated.

Heavner thanked everyone for all of their work on the Christmas Tree Lighting ceremony and encouraged Trustees to comment on any changes they feel may be necessary in the schedule or programming of the event.

Heavner said that trees will be relocated from the tree farm to the original town area on December 16. He has contacted Luke Edler to handle the planting of the trees, so it won't be like trying to put a round peg in a square hole.

New Business:

Heavner reported that the annual financial report was received from fountain Water District. He said the Village cost of water was increased from \$8.40 per 1000 gallons to \$8.44 per 1000 gallons.

Knobloch reported that the County is working with the municipalities in the County to create an organized America 250 celebration in 2026. The first event will be a County-wide Ringing of the Bells to take place on January 1, 2026, at Noon. The Valmeyer event will take place at Village Hall at Noon on that day. More details of the event will be provided at the second December meeting of the Valmeyer Village Board.
