REGULAR MEETING

Roll Call: Howard Heavner, Kyle Duffy, Rob Nowlan, Tim Valentine and Kaylee Dependahl were all present, with Adam Tyberendt and Butch Ford absent. Also in attendance were Dennis Knobloch, Larry Andres, Tim Richards, Terry Marquardt, Frank Haynes and Jeremy Eckenfels. There being a quorum present the meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by President Heavner, at the Village Hall.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved with a motion by Valentine, second by Nowlan, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion carried.

The monthly expenditures were read. A motion to approve was made by Duffy, second by Dependahl, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion carried.

The maintenance report as presented. A motion to approve was made by Nowlan, second by Valentine, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion passed.

The police report was reviewed. A motion to approve was made by Dependahl, second by Nowlan, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion passed. Marquardt gave an update stating that he has 2 part-time academy slots reserved for Allen and Schilling. Haynes will take part in his transition course June 1-12 and then must take his state test.

Old Business:

Richards stated that we are waiting to hear back if the Barmann's are okay with the Village moving forward with starting work on the storm drain in their backyard.

Henke came out last week to evaluate Christ's backyard storm drain. They suggested replacing the collapsed pipe and running it straight out, rather than the current layout. The pipe needs to be located so they know exactly where the pipe is. Richards will need to talk to Garavalia regarding the Harget drainage issue.

New Business:

Stuckmeyer stated that we need to act on upcoming bank account changes. Duffy made a motion, effective June 1, 2026, Larry Andres be removed from the bank accounts, Rick Holmes added and Ashley

Stuckmeyer added as a signer to the bank accounts, second by Dependahl, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion passed.

Eckenfels presented tractor bids stating that our current tractor needs to be replaced. Sydenstricker has a used John Deere with 300 hours. We will still get the current warranty and will be able to add a new warranty once the current warranty runs out. The bids presented were a new John Deere for \$145,000, a new Case for \$117,000 and the used John Deere for \$122,000. The new tractors would have to be ordered and would not be available for 6+ months. John Deere has 4.9% for 60months. Andres has not had a chance to see what kind of financing we could get through the bank. Valentine made a motion for Andres to investigate the different financing options for the used John Deere and proceed with the best financing option, second by Duffy, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion passed.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn at 7:48 p.m. was made by Duffy, second by Nowlan, all aye, Tyberendt and Ford absent, motion carried.
